Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your ongoing support throughout this pandemic. Unfortunately, the cases in Hounslow and in many London boroughs have doubled or tripled over the last 10 days. This new strain of the virus is far more easily transmitted and we need to do all we can to keep our community safe.

The government has asked a few areas to close schools and Hounslow is one of these areas, due to the current high levels of the virus in our area.

Mrs Farid, our school business manager will be sending out a survey today to request new information. If your child was previously on our Critical Worker or Vulnerable list, please can you confirm that you still need this place.

If your child is new to the school or joined Reception in September, please let us know if both parents are critical workers and you require a place in school over the next two weeks.

Online learning will be provided for all children through the following platforms;

- EYFS on Tapestry
- KS1 & KS2 on Google Classrooms

Teachers will be keeping a register of those children accessing the learning each day and will contact parents if children are not accessing the learning to resolve issues.

The timings of the school day and entry to school for critical worker and vulnerable children will be the same as usual.

We will be in touch regarding free school meal provision as soon as we confirm if it is weekly vouchers or food parcels.

Clubs and before after school activities will be postponed until further notice.
