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

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		Once children are confident choose different children to create their own rhythm for the others to copy. Support the children to explain their sound pattern, using words, as they begin to play.			
Session 2	Read the story Kipper's birthday. Talk about how in the story Kipper's birthday was celebrated. Ask the children to look at the pictures of how we celebrate birthdays in Nursery	Sing number nursery rhymes, pointing out the numbers that they have sang. 5 little ducks, 5 conkers, 1,2,3,4,5 5 little monkeys.	Reread Kipper's birthday story and talk about the things that are the same with their own birthdays and kippers and the things that are different. Use a thinking frame to record children's responses.
