Please check that all water bottles and cardigans/jumpers are named.


Please apply sun screen to your child before they come in the morning.


This week we will read the story The Squirrels who squabbled and use this to talk about how we can resolve conflicts in Nursery between friendships.

Physical development

We will be working on our fine motor skills and making butterflies using the playdough, following some pictorial instructions and then making their own.



In the garden, we will be developing the children's gross motor skills by using ball and encouraging the children to use 2 hands to catch. We will use a large ball initially.

Talk about patterns all around and how they are everywhere. We will be looking at the caterpillars and noticing any changes daily. We will continue to talk about the life cycle of the butterfly and what stage our Nursery caterpillars are at.



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We will also look at spatial patterns (ones involving symmetry) especially in the outdoor area and the children will be making their own symmetrical butterflies.

We will also be looking at the numbers on seed packets of sunflowers and thinking about the months of the year and when they need to be planted and



The children will look carefully at sunflowers and they will use a variety of different media to make their own sunflower masterpieces.
