Aspect 3 - Activity 1
Miss Oh No's musical movement.

Children will be copying, listening to and making their own body sounds. Children will be listening carefully and copying sounds they can hear.

White Rose Maths - Exploring repeats.

Children will read the story We're going on a leaf hunt and join in with the repeats.

Singing of lots of songs with repeated refrains, emphasising the vocabulary repeat.

The children will be reading Autumn stories and thinking about the changes that are happening to the leaves and outside.



The children will be making their own leaf print pictures, choosing colours and practicing pressing down the leaves, pressing their hands down to build up strength.

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
