In this final lesson, you add a top layer of pastels to the piece and explore blends - working on top of the base layer of the wash of watered down acrylics with some sections of dotted paint on top.

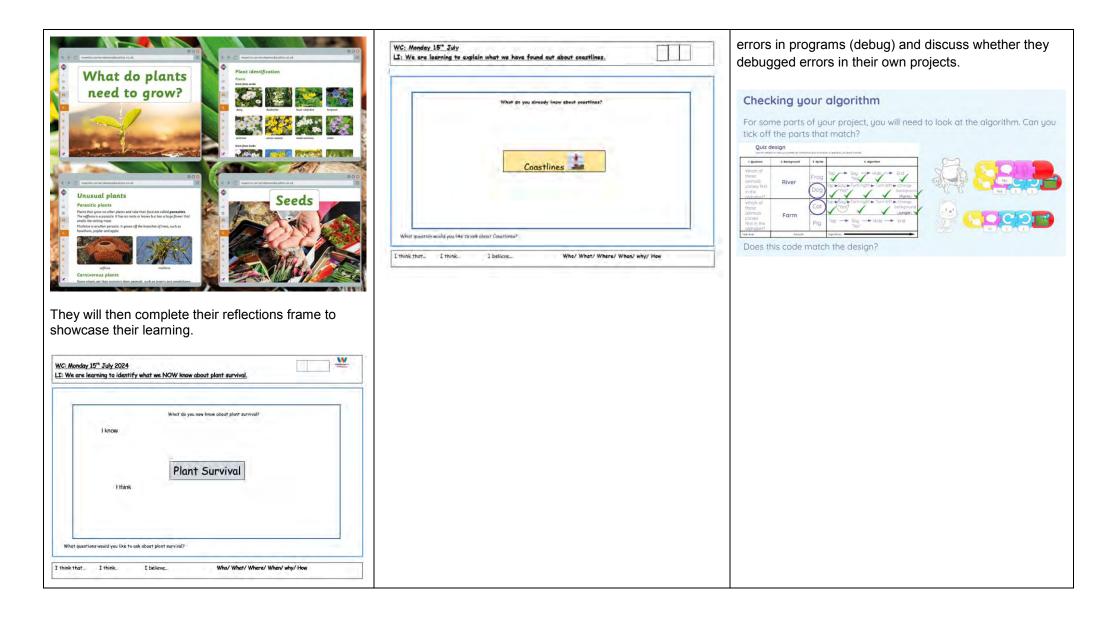
